
#### **BUR 1 consolidates:**

# Country experience on the six main steps for BUR/ICA



- Step 1 Appointing the BUR team
- Step 2 Taking stock
- Step 3 BUR and MRV planning
- Step 4 BUR compilation and MRV set up
- Step 5 ICA preparation
- Step 6 Making improvement

# Information Matters Transparency through Reporting



## **Conclusions on Tool**

- ✓ Function: The tool works properly when entering the information
- ✓ Results: Estimation of the calculated time periods works properly
- ✓ Scope and approach: Tool captures all key steps and activities necessary for the process
- ✓ **User-friendliness:** Structure is easy to follow, time-estimating buttons are easy to understand
- ✓ Clarity: Text is very clear, easily readable and well arranged
