

## What is likely to be expected from the FMCP?

Pursuant to the MPGs, the FMCP, which follows the TER, consists of the following:

- Steps:
  - Written question and answer session: Parties can submit questions through an online platform and the Party undergoing the FMCP is to answer questions in writing, with some flexibility in the time available to answer these questions for developing countries.
  - In a working group session organised by the SBI, the Party presents its BTR, followed by a discussion session. Questions raised during the working group session can be answered in writing after the session.
- Scope:
  - Implementation and achievement of the NDCs.
  - Efforts under Art. 9 (only applicable to developing countries who have provided support, reported on it and agreed to be reviewed with regards to this information).
- Timing: The FMCP takes place as early as possible once the TER review report has been published.
- Online platform: the UNFCCC secretariat will establish an online platform for the submission of questions and answers. This platform should also facilitate Parties holding webinars (e.g. for answering questions before or after the working group session) and Party experts participating remotely in the working group sessions.
- Record: The UNFCCC secretariat will publish a record of the FMCP within one month of the working group session. This includes among other questions and answers, the Party's presentation, the working group session recording and a procedural summary of the FMCP.
