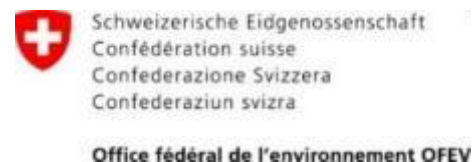

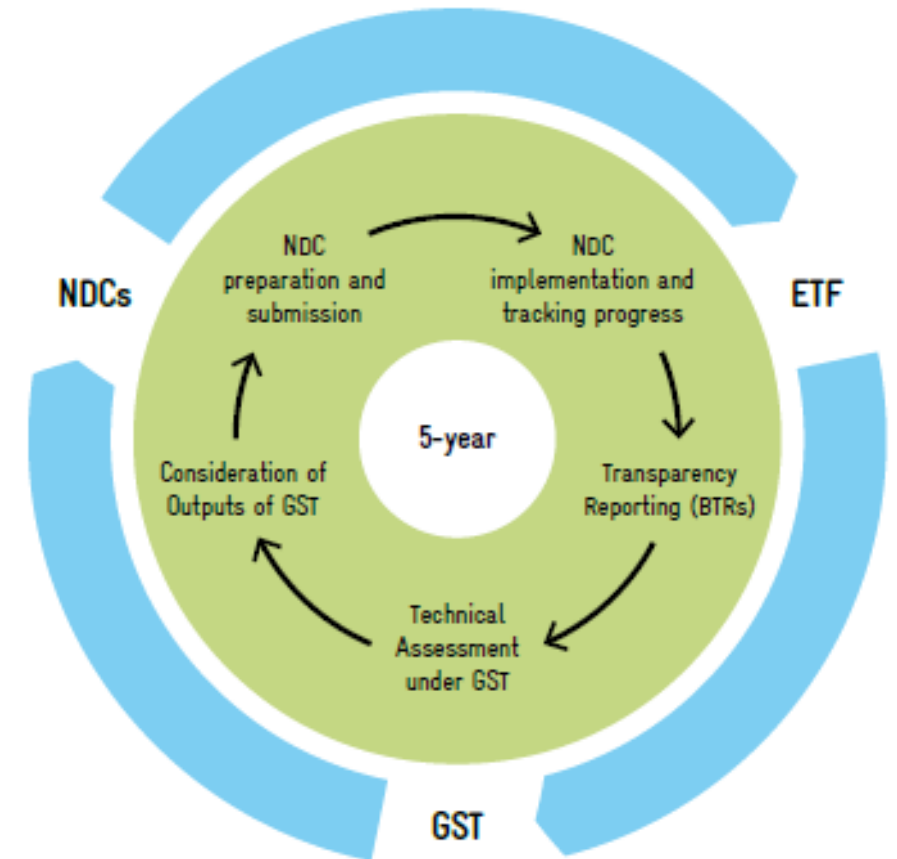

Group discussion on implementing the ETF

How do countries implement at the **national level** the outcomes of the ETF that were negotiated at the **international level**?

- Negotiations intend to create the rules → framework for action at the national level.
- As for the ETF, the rules created a complex ecosystem that include the MPGs, CRTs, CTFs, outlines, etc
- Recipients (practitioners) may interpret rules in a different manner (language of decisions!)
- Transparency provisions are highly technical in nature → technical understanding and capacity building are required for their implementation

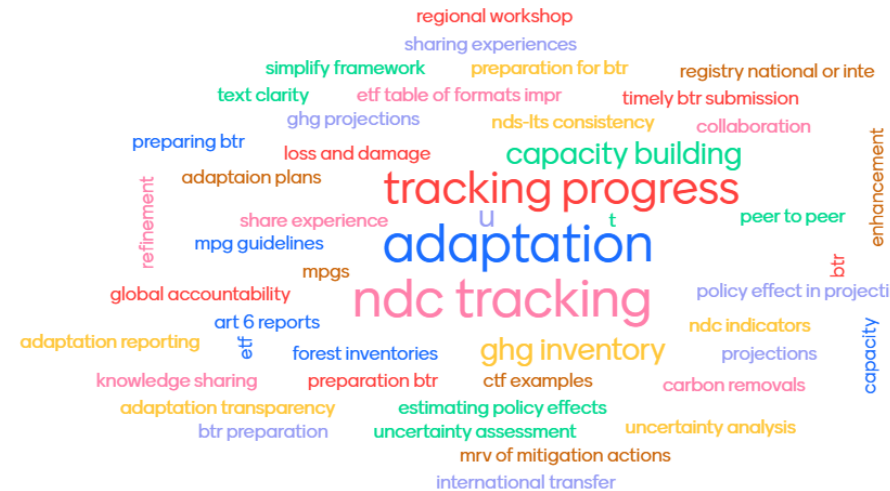
